This DVD/Video is designed to make citizenship education accessible and stimulating. The classroom strategies presented here, show primary school children as active citizens, in a wide range of schools.

The pack contains a DVD or Video and supporting CD Rom. It is divided into 7 separate parts.

**Part 1 Stimulate empathy and communication** - a small rural all white school prepares to welcome an African Muslim child - letter writing activity (Year 3/4).

**Part 2 Build relationships based on respect for oneself and others** - class contracts and social responsibility in school are explained to a visiting Persona Doll (Year 2).

**Part 3 Unlearn prejudice and discriminatory attitudes** - examining our assumptions and revealing prejudice by working on fragments of photographs (Year 3/4).

**Part 4 Think about refugees and asylum seekers** - treating others as we would like to be treated; children preparing to change schools think about refugees 'on the move' (Year 5/6).

**Part 5 Expand feelings of identity and a sense of belonging** - children in divided communities in Oldham and Bradford link up and share an inclusive curriculum (four schools Years 3-6).

**Part 6 Talk about racism and take action to combat it** - the *Heartstone Odyssey* provides a stimulating environment for understanding the corrosive impact of racism and how to combat it (Yr 4).

**Part 7 Practice democracy and take action to bring about change** - the school council organises a pupil survey, followed by focus groups and one-to-one interviews as part of a whole school anti-racist citizenship initiative (whole school).

A **Support Book** on CD Rom is included, with downloadable briefings on Citizenship education, plus support materials for activities, with additional case studies and further resources.
